

CONTINUING EDUCATION FACT SHEET

COMAR 10.41.03.06-Continuing Education

Within in the 2 year renewal period immediately preceding the licensee's application for renewal, the licensees shall earn 20 continuing education units (CEUs) as follows:

- **10 CEUs in the area of licensure; and**
- **10 CEUs in the area related to speech-language pathology or audiology or both, including practice management.**

An individual licensed as both an audiologist and a speech-language pathologist shall earn 30 CEUs as follows:

- **10 CEUs in each area of licensure; and**
- **10 CEUs in area related to speech-language pathology, audiology, including practice management.**

Time Period for CEUs

- **A licensee shall complete the required CEUs within the two year renewal period.**
- **Continuing education units may not be carried over from one renewal period to the next**
- **The Board shall waive all continuing education requirements for a speech-language pathologist or audiologist obtaining licensure within the 2 year renewal cycle. This includes newly licensed individuals, reinstatements and transfers from other states.**

Continuing Education Audit and Documentation Procedures

- **At each renewal period , the Board shall audit 10 percent of the renewal applications**
- **The Board members shall be audited for required CEUs**
- **A licensee shall retain supporting documents for inspection by the Board for 4 years after the date of renewal**

COMAR 10.41.11.09 -Continuing Education Requirements (CEU) for Speech-Language Pathology Assistants

A speech-language pathology assistant shall earn a minimum of 10 CEUs as a condition of renewal as follows:

- **5 CEUs in the area of clinical practice; and**
- **5 CEUs in work related areas**
- **The Board shall audit 25 percent of the speech-language pathology assistants**
- **If the speech-language pathology assistant is audited by the Board, the speech-language pathology assistant shall submit to the Board a copy of the most recent performance evaluation.**
